## Aluminium and steel cans:

- ✓ Soft drinks cans
- ✓ Alcohol cans
- ✓ Empty aerosols
- ✓ Tinned food cans
- ✓ Pet food cans



## Paper and card:

- ✓ Newspapers
- ✓ Magazines
- ✓ Paper (not shredded)
- ✓ Cereal cartons
- ✓ Card
- ✓ Junk mail & pamphlets
- ✓ Catalogues
- ✓ Yellow Pages / directories



## Empty plastic bottles:

- ✓ Soft drinks bottles
- ✓ Fruit juice bottles
- ✓ Milk bottles
- ✓ Fabric conditioner bottles
- ✓ Cooking oil bottles
- ✓ Shampoo & toiletry bottles
- ✓ Household cleaner bottles

If an item **IS NOT** on this list, please put it in your household green waste bin or take it to the nearest household waste and recycling centre.

Please put recyclables loose in the grey bin – **DO NOT** place them in carrier bags or sacks. Please remove tops and place in your household waste bin. Rinse containers.

Please take your glass bottles and jars to the nearest bottle bank.
